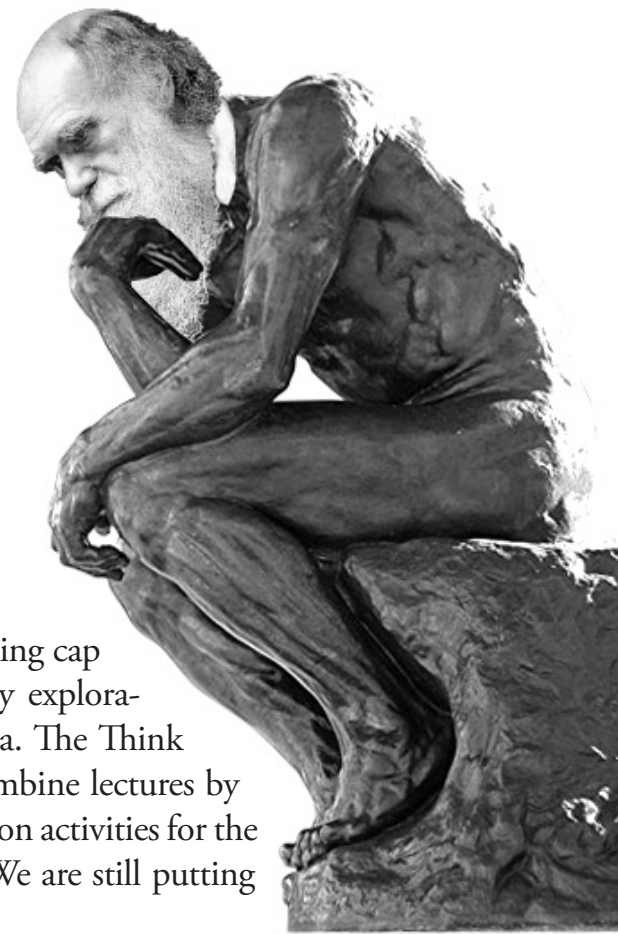


Think Evolution IX
