# Glossary

### amniotic egg

[am knee ott ick] an egg with a fluid-filled amniotic sac that cushions and protects the developing embryo

### bipedal

[bi pea dull] describing an animal that typically walks on two legs.

### bony skeleton

a skeleton formed from hardened bone, not cartilage.

#### common ancestor

an ancestor shared by two or more lineages.

## genealogy

[gee knee all oh gee] a family history.

## hypothesis

[hi poth i sis] a testable statement about the natural world that can be used to explain an observation and or make an inference.

## lineage

[lin ee edge] any continuous line of descent; those organisms connected by heredity from ancestor to descendent.

#### most recent common ancestor

the most recently shared ancestor of two or more lineages.

#### quadrupedal

[qwa drew pea dull] describing an animal that typically walks on four legs.

#### tetrapod

[tet tra pod] an animal having four limbs for terrestrial locomotion.

#### vertebrate

an animal having a back bone or spinal column.
